Give A Brick is the vision of Cross Hands Christian Centre in South Wales. We believe that God has a purpose for our little chapel in the Gwendraeth Valley and after updating our business plan in 2006, we identified a number of key areas of need in the community.

Our accommodation is smaller than we need for community work and includes an outside WC inaccessible to disabled visitors so we first set about obtaining planning permission for an extension.

One year on and we are pleased to announce that this has been granted. This is where the hard work really begins! How does a congregation of less than 30 finance the building of a new toilet block and four classrooms?

The simple answer is that on our own it would have been completely impossible. But nothing is impossible when God has a plan. Give A Brick is His plan which we believe He will use to expand our work in Cross Hands.

Give A Brick will go on to support other projects throughout the UK and abroad. Why? So that the world can see how amazing He is.

Give A Brick asks everyone to give one brick. Before you pop over to your nearest DIY store, please understand that a brick is £1. We will use your £1 to buy actual bricks for community projects like ours in Cross Hands. We will also use your £1 to buy virtual bricks: bricks that build opportunities; bricks that rebuild lives; bricks that make people smile.

We are registering Give A Brick with the Charities Commission. As soon as this is complete, we will be launching Give A Brick to the media via press releases and magazine articles. The aim of this exposure is to ask every body to give just one brick (£1). Some people may choose to give more than one but the hook of Give A Brick is that everyone gives just £1.
